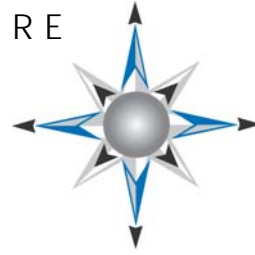

### Overall favorite photo

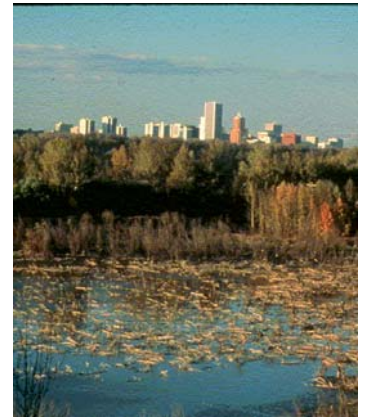

**How to submit a photo:** You may submit prints or digital photos (digital files preferred). No negatives or slides, please. **Technical specifications:** Photos may be in color or black and white. Prints should be at least 3" x 5". JPEG (.jpg) is the preferred format for digital files. Digital photos should be of high quality, and at least 400 pixels wide.
